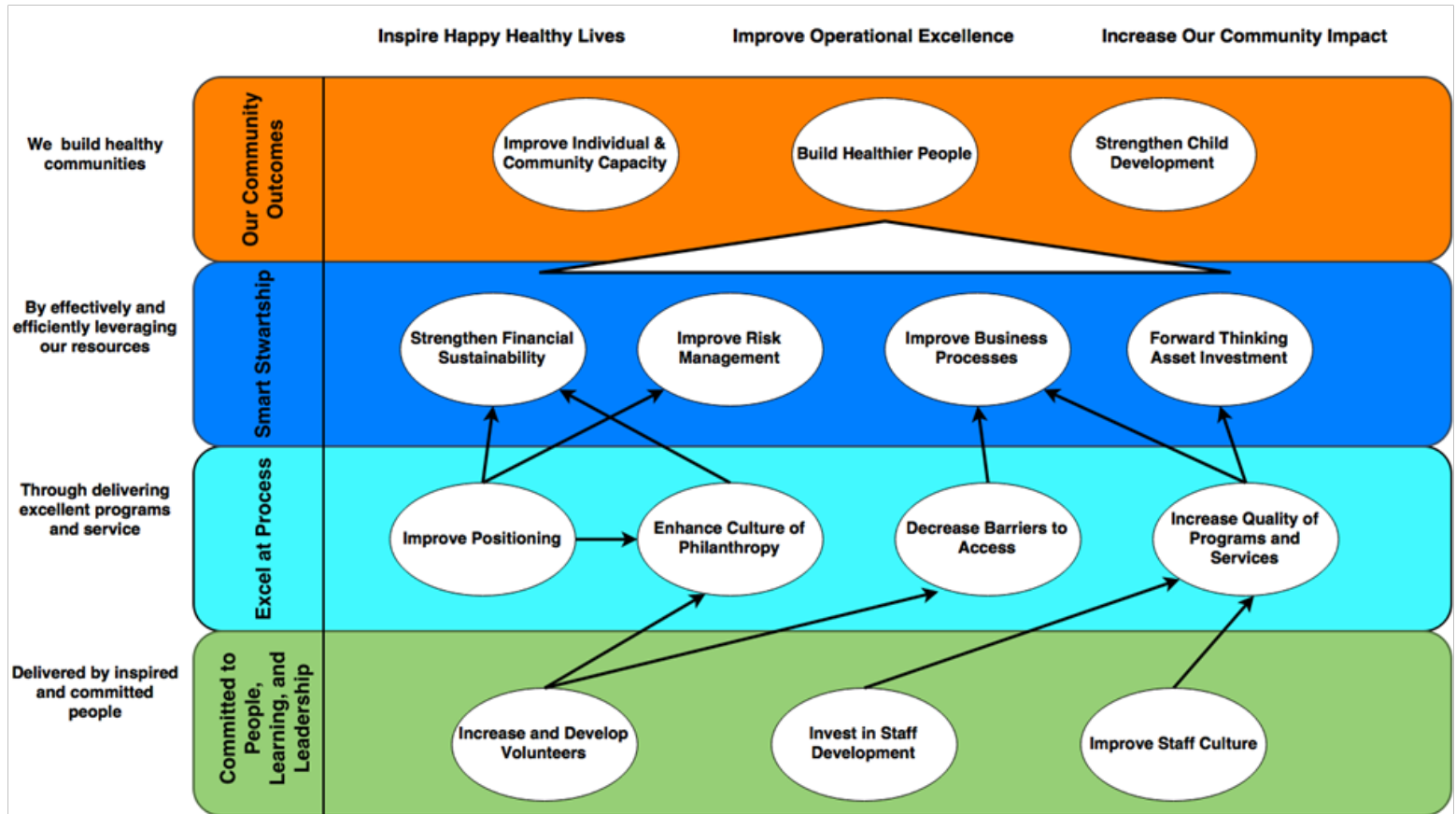

# YMCA Beyond the Bell

## Addressing Issues:

In Saskatchewan, 30,000 children and youth from low-income families are at higher-risk of health problems, emotional & intellectual developmental delays, and social behaviour disorders.



As a result, they also typically lack supports and are more likely to fall behind their grade level peers; this is referred to as the achievement gap.
