## Registration

Day Camp registration is available by contacting Stephanie Ramsey or ONLINE through your Active Net Account. Registration remains open until the camp is full. Limited spaces are available and are assigned on a first come, first served basis. If the camp is full, please add your child(ren) to the wait list and we will contact you if a space becomes available.

### *Cancellation/Refund Policy*

- Full refunds will be issued if Day Camp is not able to operate due to low enrollment.
- Full refunds will be issued for cancellation requests made on or before the "cancel by date".
- Cancellation requests made after the "cancel by date" are non-refundable.
  - Exceptions may be considered for confirmed medical reasons with proper documentation (*doctor's note*).
- No refunds will be issued if a camper is sent home due to code of conduct violations or illness.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **About Camp Fees**

*My child attends YMCA Before and After School Programs. Am I eligible to pay the discounted Member rate on summer camps?*

Member rates are reserved for summer campers who hold active YMCA Family or Youth memberships. Registrants of school-based programs are not provided complimentary YMCA memberships, and therefore are not eligible for discounted rates.

*I do not require a full week of camp. Can my child attend a partial week?*

If a camper is registered partway through a week, the fees associated with that week will be prorated. If a camper is withdrawn partway through a week, no refund for the remainder of the week will be issued as per the YMCA refund/cancellation policy.

### **About Programming and Schedules**

*What qualification do camp staff have?*

YMCA Day camps are developed, administered, and supervised by full-time YMCA staff. Staff are recruited from educational and health studies fields, and are selected for their maturity, experience and skills with children. Staff selection includes a thorough background check and current Police Information Check. YMCA staff receive a comprehensive, multi-day training that includes YMCA Child Protection, Standard First Aid & CPR, YMCA Healthy Child Development, and emergency procedures.

*What's planned for camp activities?*

Camp activities are planned around weekly themes where each child's interests and individuality can be celebrated. Campers can expect themes infused into creative arts and sciences, games, activities, and outings into the community. To maximize fun, campers will also have the opportunity for sports, swimming, and outdoor play. Staff consistently monitor camper activity and remain flexible to extend, reorder, or revisit planned activities wherever appropriate.

*Who swims with my child?*

Day Camp staff will facilitate activities in the pool and swim with campers while lifeguards supervise the aquatic environment. Campers able to demonstrate comfort in the water and complete the facility swim test (1 pool length, uninterrupted) may swim independently. Life jackets will be provided to all campers who are not able to successfully complete the swim test, and are 5 years of age.
